

Shaw River Completes 4,000 Metre Drill Program at Baramine Manganese Project

Shaw River Resources Limited ("Shaw River") (ASX Code: SRR) is pleased to advise that it has completed a 4,000 metre RC drilling program over previously identified and new targets at its prospective Baramine Manganese Project (SRR 70%, Mn, Fe Rights) in the Pilbara Region of Western Australia. The Baramine Manganese Project is located 80km to the north west of the operating Woodie Woodie Manganese Mine in similar geology.

The 54-hole drill program was designed to follow up a range of previous drilled manganese targets, and to test new geophysical and structural geology targets across the extensive target geology exposed at Baramine. The company is expects to release the assay results from this drilling program in mid-January 2010.

Follow up drilling of up to 6,000m is currently being planned for March/April 2010.

Background on Shaw River

Shaw River is a manganese focused explorer, currently operating 5 Pilbara manganese projects, and holding an option to secure an 80% stake in a Ghanaian manganese project. The company's largest shareholder, Atlas Iron is a strong supporter of Shaw River's manganese strategy.
